In celebrating the birth of John the Baptist, we are indeed celebrating the manifold graciousness of God in granting us Salvation (as quoted in the First Reading

John the Baptist was a marked Man!

from the prophet Isaiah).

John was, chosen, conceived, born, named, missioned, preached, died - all pointing to Christ. John was the precursor, He pointed to Jesus and to Salvation.

Many remarkable circumstances surrounded the conception and birth of John the Baptist. But the centre piece for this Solemnity is the naming of John the name given to Zechaiah by the Angel Gabriel. "John" means "the Lord is gracious."

God's manifold graciousness continues into our own graced lives. We must be as faithful to our identity and mission as was John. God's interventions might not be so dramatic in our lives. But God still acts on behalf of each of us. We must do the simple everyday things well, in Jesus' name. We truly are precursors, too!
