SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME Year B - 21st & 22nd July, 2018

> In today's Gospel we see the compassion and the human understanding that Jesus has for His people. He is tired, the Apostles are tired, yet the crowds still continue to follow him wherever He goes.

> He could have sent them away, but again His human compassion takes over, He lets them stay and begins to preach the Good News of forgiveness and hope to them.

Jesus sees these villagers, shepherds and fishermen, as 'sheep without a shepherd' wondering around half lost, for these country people have been more or less forgotten and neglected by the great theologians in the city.

How fortunate were they to have found the True Shepherd? How fortunate are we to receive the True shepherd in the Eucharist?

Merciful Father, may these mysteries give us new purpose and bring us to a new life in you.


