

'Safe Schools Program'- Concerns

The 'Safe Schools Program was an issue that was highlighted during the debate on Same Sex Marriage in 2017. When Gay Marriage came to Law gender was removed from the legal definition of Marriage. As a consequence of this re definition there has and will be consequential changes to sex education exposing children to gender ideology, gay and lesbian sex education and kids being taught that gender is fluid. Parents are excluded from their kids' sex education. These program are already in some Government Primary and Secondary schools but will be mandatory if the Labor Government is returned to Office.

The Australian Christian Lobby will be running a campaign to highlight the issues surrounding the Labor Government's so called 'Safe Schools Program'. If you have similar concerns and would like to be involved in the campaign, please attend a meeting at the Parish Office on Tuesday the 21st of August at 7.15pm. The objective of the campaign is to alert voters of the dangers of the Safe School Program that seeks to sexualise our primary and secondary school children with emphasis on gay and lesbian practices, so that parents are properly informed when voting at the upcoming State Election on the 24th of November.
