We have spent the last four weeks listening to Jesus' teachings about the Bread of Life. In this week's Gospel, we see even some of the disciples confused and disbelieving.

However, one of the twelve, Simon Peter, looks past his doubts and when Jesus ask him if he wants to leave, Peter answers, "Master to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life."

With what has gone before us, it is much easier for us to understand and believe. The problem is many of us make the choice to stay with Jesus, but live this new self-giving life only half heartedly. We must be prepared to judge our belief, not on what we say or think, but on what we do.


