

# St Vincent de Paul Society – Observance Sunday

The Archdiocese has listed Sunday the 7th October as a Special Observance Sunday to highlight the "goodworks" of the St Vincent de Paul Society also known as "Vinnies" and to thank the Catholic community for its support.

The Society has been operating in Victoria since 1854; the Society operates at a local level; setting up groups in parishes known as "conferences" who respond to requests for assistance in their local area.

We assist families and individuals who fall on hard times, our motto is "a hand up not a hand out". In our conference we typically receive 35 to 40 calls per month for assistance, our members visit the families in pairs and determine what their needs are and how best to assist. We also distribute approximately 50 hampers at Christmas made up from donations from the parish and a number of local schools.

The Society operates a number of Vinnies Op shops where second hand goods are available for sale, the funds raised are distributed to outreach programs including a number of soup vans.
