In today's gospel, Jesus sends his 72 disciples out to the towns as if sending labourers to an abundant harvest. Jesus' ministry is now being extended through the disciples whom he sends forth to do his work and thus announce that the "kingdom of God is at hand."

When the disciples return reporting their many successes, Jesus reveals that the real abundance of the harvest is in having their "names written in heaven." Jesus redirects the focus of the disciples from power over evil to the glory of dwelling in the kingdom.

Our ministry then, is the same as the early disciples and that is to announce that the kingdom of God is at hand.

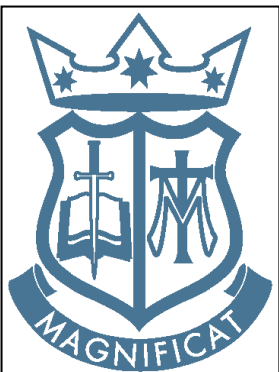

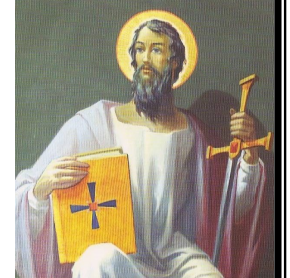

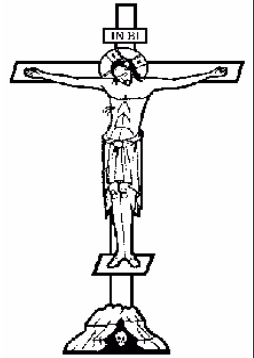
