1. Certain support activities require a greater degree of training and commitment than the ordinary service activities that are available to parents of McLeod Community League athletes.
2. These activities primarily relate to enrolment and pre-season organization of athletic activities.
3. In such cases, the director of the program (or the program committee, if one exists) shall have the opportunity to present a motion to the Board to either waive fees altogether or to reduce fees by any amount up to the total amount of fees that shall be spent.
4. As this is effectively a financial commitment (reduction in revenues), such activity should only take place with Board approval.
5. This can be presented as either a separate motion, or coupled with the budget presented by the particular program in its ordinary budget approval process.
6. Sports Directors should be mindful that sports programs are normally run on a cost recovery basis, and that any reduced revenue puts a financial strain on the Community League, and means that less funds are available for other activities.
