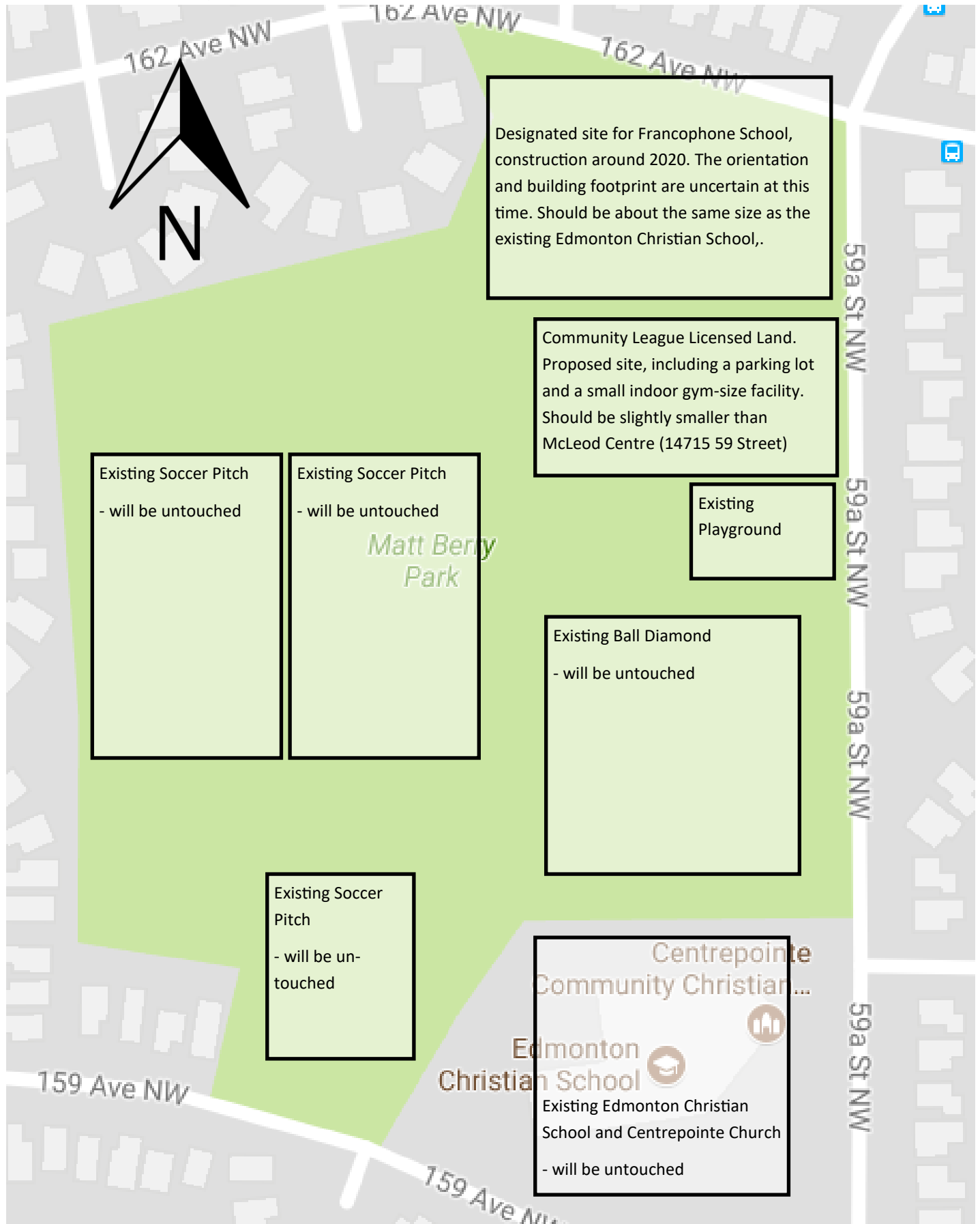


Matt Berry Facilities Steering Committee:

Door to Door Survey #2 of Area Residents



About this survey:

The Matt Berry Facilities Steering Committee operates as a Committee of the McLeod Community League.

Since late 2014, the Steering Committee has been working towards installing a Community Facility in Matt Berry Park. Based on two rounds of surveys, plus a public consultation, plus work with the City, it is presently planned that we will oversee the construction of a multi-use facility. This facility is likely going to comprise a parking lot, a small indoor gym and a small number of multi-purpose rooms. We are attempting to secure a partnership with at least one other non-profit agency to jointly occupy this space with us. The intent is to build a facility that will be useable by neighbourhood residents for sport, recreation, and community events year-round, and survive for generations of future use. There will not be a full kitchen, so the facility will not be suitable for weddings or similar events. The plan, presently, is to begin construction in 2019 and have the facility fully up and running by the end of that year. Existing sports fields will not be impacted.

As a separate and unrelated project, there is a Francophone School (K-9) proposed for the northeast corner of this Park. This facility is likely to be built in 2020 or thereabouts. The Francophone School Board, to this point, has shown no willingness to partner on this project. This committee has no influence over anything related to that project.

The facility is not permitted to be a 'destination' facility, so it should not attract large numbers of users from outside the neighbourhood.
