Today, Official Love strives to equip and prepare others to positively contribute to society through sports officiating. In less than a year, Official Love has built strong relationships with several community organizations. These connections include the Rochester Area Foundation, Rochester Amateur Sports Commission, Rochester Public Library, Rochester Area Family YMCA, Elite Playmakers, Bolder Options, Boys & Girls Club, and Champion Basketball. Through these partnerships, donors, and supporters, membership with Official Love will include provision of uniforms and equipment, vouchers for registration fees and dues, transportation assistance, training resources, and connection with a mentor. Membership is open to males and females at least 16 years of age.

The officiating profession provides diverse opportunities for teamwork, networking, and professional development. Official Love is committed to promoting equity, diversity, and inclusion through the recruitment and support of members, board members, mentors, and volunteers.
