In its 16th year, the ACAA provides this opportunity to showcase the work of local artists by offering the public a free exhibit of artists who live and work in Amador County.

Artists will have their work displayed in the historic Sutter Creek Auditorium. In addition, we host a Fine Art Raffle that supports the ACAA's fundraising efforts for student art awards, artist demonstrations and high school student scholarships.

The ACAA heavily publicizes the show with signs, posters, and announcements in magazines, newspapers and social media.

There are only 25 spaces so artists are assigned space on a first-come, first-served basis. Spaces are 10'x10' and may be shared. (Everyone's help is needed in setting up and taking down art panels before and after the show.)

Entry Fees:

ACAA members: \$55 per artist; non-members: \$70 per artist
Membership to ACAA is half price after June.

Fees Cover:

Hall space rental, printing of posters, publicity, calendar listings; handouts and posters at the fair, businesses and other events around the area; local and regional newspaper ads.

ACAA Membership

The purpose of the Amador County Artists Association (ACAA) is to promote and encourage the production, cultivation and appreciation of art. The ACAA's Art in Amador show is an event that does this for artists and attendees alike.

It is also our primary fundraising event to raise money for the High School Student Art Show, artist demonstrations, and for our annual scholarships that we give to local high school students pursuing an art major in college.

ACAA manages the Fine Arts and Photography Departments at the Amador County Fair in July, which gives adults and youth the chance to show their work publicly and win ribbons and cash awards.

ACAA coordinates the local program Art in Public Places, showcasing members' work at a variety of local businesses.

Members of ACAA are very active in art activities. Members mingle with other artists at monthly professional technique demonstrations and meetings. Our website, www.amadorartists.org, the Facebook page (Amador County Artists Association) and newsletter publish art related news, such as call to artist opportunities, such as call to artist opportunities, and member events.

To participate:

Fill out the application form and submit with appropriate fees. The art is not juried, but we do expect professional-level work from all participants that is ready to be displayed. The fee and any monies you choose to spend in preparation and promotion are your only costs; all income from sales is your own.

Membership in the ACAA is not a requirement, although it is encouraged simply because there are other benefits to joining. Artists are welcome to join the Art in Amador group on Facebook to stay abreast of information and tips.

Art show committee meetings occur on the 2nd Wed. of each month, at 1pm, prior to the regular ACAA meeting. You are encouraged to attend.

Your responsibilities are:

Email a .jpg photo of your work for use in publicity. Suggested min. 300 dpi. Printed poster photo will be approximately 1.5" x 1.5". We can help with photos. (Check box on application.) Early deadline is so we can get poster out with artists' work to advertise the show.

Publicize the event to your email list and on social media.

Donate a piece of **original art** (no prints or giclees, photos being the exception) to the Artists' Raffle, our scholarship fundraiser. **Artwork must be wired to hang or ready for display and weigh no more than 15 lbs.** These will be collected Oct. 12, from 3 to 5pm at Judy Day's home, 20 Rollingwood Drive #195, Jackson.

Set up your own display space before the venue is open. You must bring your own tables; chairs are provided. There are a limited number of art panels available so first come, first served. Food will not be for sale at the event but there is a refrigerator for your convenience.

Handle your own sales, collections and tax obligations.

Help with set up and tear down of the event.

Provide after-show feedback to improve future events.
