For any upcoming holiday, check our web-page or call the 24-hour telephone message at 239-9278. Do not *assume* there is a change. Put your can out the night before your pick-up unless you have checked the webpage or called and seen there is a change.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

(check the web-page, Facebook or the 24-hour office message)

In the event of snow or ice or other Weather conditions that make it unsafe for our drivers and for others on the road, put your can out if you can safely do so for



your regular scheduled pick-up and it will be gotten as soon as we are able to.

WHY CAN'T WE GIVE YOU AN EXACT TIME FOR YOUR PICK UP: Traffic conditions, the number of customers who put out their cans or who have extra with their cans, roadwork, impending bad weather, and so many factors affect the day's schedule. BE SAFE! PUT IT OUT THE NIGHT BEFORE.

A NOTE TO RECYCLING CUSTOMERS

REMINDER: NO Styrofoam, food, medical waste, foam rubber, fluorescent bulbs, dirt, construction materials, yard debris, clothing, ammunition, sheetrock or wood in the recycling bins. When non-recyclable items are put in the bins or bags, it contaminates all the recycling in the bin and causes the truck load to be rejected by the recycling center. Those cans of recycling then have to go in the landfill. Also, put your excess recycling in bags rather than on top of the can so the top can close.

MORE SOLUTIONS!!

BULK ITEMS - FURNITURE, APPLIANCES

Call us before setting these items out with your can. In an effort to decrease the items in the landfill, appliances, grills, lawnmowers, tools and anything containing metal may be picked up separately. We suggest that Items "gently used" be donated to organizations such as Interfaith Outreach, Habitat for Humanity (will take working flat screen tv's and small appliances), and Goodwill (will take electronics, computers – no tv's).

LEAVES AND BRUSH

If you have a large amount of leaves or brush, call us for pricing to pick these up for you. (Please, dry leaves and clippings – when wet they are very heavy-increasing landfill costs). We will take up to 5 bags with your trash. Leaves do not compact well in the truck and require that we make extra trips to the landfill in order to complete a day's route. Spreading them in a wooded area or a composting bin is helpful. We will pick up discarded CHRISTMAS TREES with your regular collection. (Suggestion: If you have a wooded area in which to dispose of your tree, the birds and small animals will love the shelter it offers).

MORE SOLUTIONS - Continued COMPOSTING IS BENEFICIAL AND EASY -Compost enriches soils, helps cleanup contaminated soil, helps prevent pollution, and is an economic benefit to you.

PAINT – Water-based paint may be put in the trash AFTER it is dried up – leave the top off of the can (putting sand or cat litter in will help). Once the paint is dry, the can may be put in the trash.

COOKING OIL – may be put in the trash – put the oil in a can or container with a lid before doing so.

OIL BASED PAINT and STAINS must NOT be put in the trash. Those items may be taken to the Concord Turnpike Convenience Center on specific dates (3 times a year). For more information, go to www.region2000servicesauthority.org.

MOTOR OILS (up to 5 gallons at a time) may be taken to places like Advance Auto Stores.

FLUORESCENT and MERCURY BULBS and RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES may be taken to Lowe's (just inside the entry doors) and Home Depot.

MEDICAL WASTE – NEEDLES, syringes, etc. must NOT be put in the RECYCLING can (keep in mind that individuals sort the recycling and should not handle these items). NEEDLES should be bent and put in a heavy plastic bottle (like laundry detergent bottles) and then put into the regular trash with the other items. There is a "needle clipper" available from drug stores.

PILLS AND DRUGS may be discarded in trash AFTER dissolving them in water and putting them in a bag with coffee grounds or kitty litter. **Rustburg Pharmacy**, **925 Village Hwy, and Timberlake Pharmacy**, **20276 Timberlake Rd, will accept all medications and dispose of them**.

TIRES – cannot be taken with trash. Places like Harris Tire will take them for you for a small disposal fee. The landfill will take them for you (at a cost of \$2-\$4 per tire).

BATTERIES – car and lawn mower batteries can be taken to auto supply stores. Other batteries may be taken to Lowe's and/or Home Depot for recycling.
