


Leadership Development Programme 2017-18

- engage in active research
- identify the difference between leadership and management
- analyse and use performance data
- identify effective teaching and learning
- develop the necessary skills to become an effective team leader
- manage change and continuous improvement
- identify gaps in attainment and develop leadership strategies to close the gap
- carry out a whole school improvement project that seeks with measurable impact
- participate in regular reflective conversation with a mentor
