

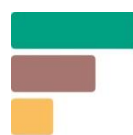

- manage change and continuous improvement
- identify gaps in attainment and develop leadership strategies to close the gap
- carry out a whole school improvement project that seeks with measurable impact
- participate in regular reflective conversation with a mentor
