Accounts for 2017

As promised here is a summary of our income and expenses since taking over financial management of the club in August 2017 when we established a new bank account:

Fees

For historical reasons when we took over running of the club we inherited different members paying different fees according to when they joined. Owing to the surplus we had in 2017 and the surplus we expect to have in 2018 we will be setting the following fees for 2018. This will result in no one paying any more but there will be a reduction for some members who joined at a later date:

Adult class	£30 per month
Junior class	£24 per month
Drop in fee (Adults)	£10 per session
Drop in fee (Juniors)	£8 per session

First lesson fee will be free for any new members.

The purpose of the drop in fee is to allow people to train on an ad hoc basis but also to encourage members to set up a direct debit.

We will also offer a discount for multiple members of the same household.
