



Quarterly Briefs from the *Fillmore County Development Corporation* **July, August, September - 2018**

Flint Hills Resources will be celebrating the completion of the new Maximized Stillage Co-Products™ production facility at the Fairmont plant. The \$50 million expansion is producing NexPro™, a high protein animal and fish feed from about 20% of their distiller's grain.

Perennial Wind LLC started operating the wind turbines west of Fairmont in late July. They stopped and restarted several times for a couple of weeks while they were making adjustments.

The 2018-2019 Odegeo...Leadership for Fillmore County started in September with thirteen participants.

Farmers and Merchants Bank in Milligan started remodeling their bank facility this summer.

Exeter has nearly finished new street paving, downtown water lines and street lighting projects.

Career Day-Industry Tours for Fillmore County juniors was held September 19 with 55 students participating. Twenty businesses were on the tour and forty five presenters gave information.

Overland Ready Mix broke ground near Strang for their new concrete facility. The plant is projected to be completed and operational in December.

A local committee is working on creating a **Geneva Multi-Generational Community Center**. \$700,000 + in donations and grants have already been secured.

Geneva Home Center is adding a warehouse to their facility.

Barks and Bubbles has moved into a newly renovated facility in Geneva for their dog grooming business.

Fillmore County Scrap Tire Collection will be held on October 26 from 8 a.m.-12 p.m. at the Fillmore County Fairgrounds. The flyer is posted in the communities and can be found on the FCDC website.
