The Market Lands is the area bordered by Princess and King Street and William and James Avenue in the Exchange District in Winnipeg.

Did you know...

- There is an underground tunnel that runs underneath Main Street connecting the Market Lands, City Hall and the Manitoba Centennial Centre.
- Market Lands was originally divided into much smaller blocks. Until 1962, people could travel right through the site on Market Avenue and Elgin Avenue.
- Under the 1875 title, the southern portion of the Market Lands site must be used for public purposes. In 1877, this was the site of a public market.


