Policy

These are private Spanish and English classes. Your success is in your hands. These private classes do not replace your regular school classes, or the commitment to practice the language every day, instead; they reinforce your efforts to help you to really become bilingual.

Honor Code

Class Preparation

In order for you to actively participate in class, we require from the student to study vocabulary beforehand. It will help you to follow the subject in class and to engage in conversation. We will also practice vocabulary and pronunciation in class. You will be given assignments to finish at home and it is your responsibility to do it.

Class Participation

You are encouraged to ask questions, to bring a subject for conversation during the first 15 minutes of the class as a way to warm up while the class starts. Participation is important and making a mistake in pronunciation, grammar, order of a sentence should not stop you from participating. These are FUN classes and we only learn when we enjoy it and relax. As you try, you will become more proficient. It is highly encouraged to use the language in social talking to process and memorize new information.

Payment and scheduling

Payment is monthly in advance. Students need to register each month on time in order to continue without interruption the course Any change in schedule should be announced in advance within 5 working days before the end of the month.

Students' attendance is your own responsibility. ***There is no make up sessions or refund for absentees. Class will close at the exact time and as soon as it starts so it is important to be on time.***

Equipment

We are not responsible for any damage to your computer or any hardware or software. We recommend you having antivirus and firewall installed and running up to date. We use a webinar software, head set with microphone and web-cam. Web-cam is not mandatory but desirable. See equipment requirements for more information.
