The wine is aged 10 months in 15% new oak barriques, predominantly French, though with a small proportion of American oak. A wine with intense berry flavours; soft, juicy tannins and finishing with the delicate floral and spice perfumes that cool climate Shiraz is known for.

The Credaro family are a pioneering family to the region, first settling in Margaret River in 1922 after migrating from Northern Italy. Now in its 5th generation (hence 5 Tales), the family manages 140 hectares of vines over seven separate vineyards across Margaret River.

SILVERADO GEO Cabernet Sauvignon 2013

Silverado Vineyards is an iconic Napa winery established by Ron & Diane Disney-Miller in 1981. Three generations later, the family continues to produce internationally-acclaimed wines. The newest addition to the line-up is the GEO Cabernet Sauvignon – Greek for “Earth” and short for “George” – sourced from their single estate Mt. George Vineyard in one of Napa’s newest AVAs Coombsville. Silverado’s Mount George vineyard was the first planted to vinifera in the Coombsville AVA. The vineyard, then known as Cedar Knoll, established its reputation in the 1880’s as a source for fine red wines, winning a silver medal at the 1889 Paris International Exposition. Aged 17 months in predominantly French oak barrels (45% new). A quintessential Napa Cab sourced from volcanic soils that is dark in colour, round and powerful; bright berry and herb aromas, dense mid palette with good structure and a long finish that encapsulates the essence of barrel and delicious blue and red fruit.

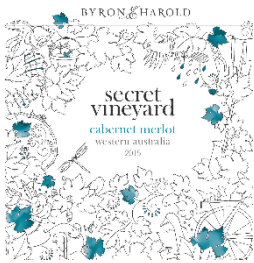

The vineyards are situated 275-320m above sea level on south, SW, and SE-facing slopes for optimal sun exposure. The vines vary in age from 7-26 years old. The wine is aged 20-22 months in large oak barrels and 6+ months in bottle before release. Elegant, with typical hints of iris, rose and red berries together with balsamic notes. Balanced, pleasantly tannic and well-bodied on the palate. A wine of great authenticity to accompany pasta with rich sauces, red meat, truffles and soft or mature cheeses.

The Contuccis have been cultivating grapes in Montepulciano since the Renaissance, and have been producing **Vino Nobile** since 1773. Their **Vino Nobile** is always produced from indigenous grapes only – Prugnolo gentile, Canaiolo nero and Colorino – sourced from their single estate Mulinvecchio vineyard. The wine is aged 18 months in oak barrels with a further 6-8 months in bottle before it is released.

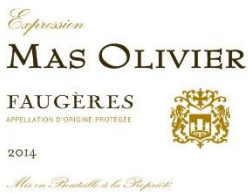
ROVEGLIA Catullo Lugana Riserva DOC 2013 \$24.95

DOC Lugana Riserva, Lombardy, Italy

This is a Lugana of great character. 100% Turbiana di Lugana, more commonly known as Trebbiano, sourced from estate vineyards on the southern shores of Lake Garda. The clayish soils are rich in mineral salts resulting in a beautiful minerality in the wine. The grapes are carefully harvested from vines that are over 55 years old. Aged 10-12 months in stainless steel vats to retain the freshness and fruit characters. The wine has a particularly rich bouquet where colder, mineral notes harmonize with ripe fruit. The aromas are mimicked on the palate and the wine finishes with a nice almond note. This a versatile wine that can be enjoyed on its own or paired with an array of fishes, pasta dishes, grilled meats, and cheeses.



MAS OLIVIER Expression Faugères 2014 \$24.95

Blend of 70% Syrah, 20% Grenache and 10% Mourvèdre hand harvested from selected plots in AOP Faugères located in the Southern French region of Languedoc. This is a *terroir*-driven expressive of the unique schist soils from which it came as well as the high elevation hilltop vineyards rising as high as 400 meters. The Syrah undergoes carbonic maceration while the Grenache and Mourvèdre undergo traditional fermentation. The separate parcels are then blended and the final wine is aged 12 months in French oak barrels. “This beauty has tons of dark, chocolatey fruit, olive tapenade, licorice and background meatiness to go with a full-bodied, low acidity, hedonistic slant on the palate that just begs to be drunk. Give bottles a year or two and enjoy through 2024.” *Jeb Dunnuck (Robert Parker, April 2016)*

Terre Stregate has long been a notable and renowned wine and oil-producing business in the Beneventano region of Campania. 100% Falanghina from high altitude vineyards (400-450m above sea level) in the Guardiési Hills of DOC Falanghina Sannio. A brilliant greenish yellow colour with intense and rich aromatics of rose, yellow fruit, spices, and vanilla. The palate is round and mouth-filling finishing off with a long, fresh and energetic splash of citrus.

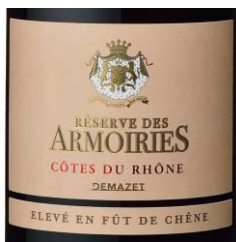


CELLIER DES PRINCES Châteauneuf du Pape 2014 \$39.95

Cellier des Princes, the only co-operative cellar in the Châteauneuf du Pape area, was established in 1925. They produce high quality wines that are always reflective of, and true to, their origin. This Châteauneuf is no exception – a blend of 90% Grenache, 5% Mourvèdre and 5% Syrah matured 8-12 months in inert vessels (no oak) to showcase the purest expression of the Grenache and the terroir. This ruby red wine is very complex and elegant with aromas of redcurrant, red cherries, black berries with herbaceous overtones such as lavender, thyme, and rosemary. Excellent balance in the mouth with elegant and silky tannins.

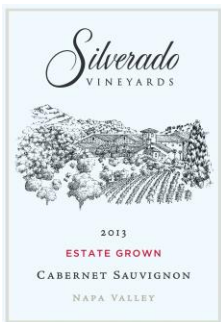

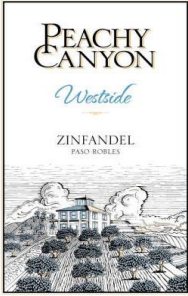
SILVERADO VINEYARDS Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 \$61.95

Peachy Canyon is a family owned and operated winery in beautiful Paso Robles. Founded by Doug and Nancy Beckett in 1988, Peachy Canyon has long been praised as a producer of award winning California wines that exemplify respect for terroir dedicated winemaking.

Zinfandel has long been Peachy Canyon's flagship varietal. Flush with ripe fruit and rich baking spices, the 2014 Westside is a bold and varietally true Zinfandel. The bottle opens with aromas of black plum, walnut, and cabinet's worth of anise, allspice, nutmeg and cocoa. On the palate, look for red and black cherry, huckleberry, and dessert spices like vanilla and clove. Lush fruit and supple tannins lend structure to this delectable Zin.

High up in the Sierra Nevada, the California Gold Country town of Auburn, lies this gem of a vineyard of Viognier planted and managed by the father and son team of John and Joe Damiano. When picked just a bit less ripe than many California Viogniers, the fruit expresses lively citrus and gentle white flower aromatics, while barrel fermentation in mostly older French oak barrels leads to a wine of perfect structure and creamy-crispy balance.

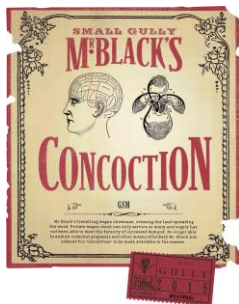

With only 38 growers, 235 hectares of vineyards, 8 Grands Crus, and numerous terroirs, quality is at the forefront of viticulture and vinification. All grapes are hand harvested with strict control of yields, and sustainable farming with some vineyards certified organic.

This 100% Riesling is hand harvested from hillside vineyards near the famous Ribeauvillé faultline, boasting an incredible diversity of terroirs. Kosher wines are produced according to very strict rules. The wine is certified Kosher for Passover (KP).

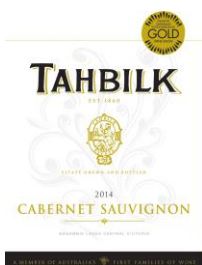

Established in 1860, Tahbilk is one of Australia's most beautiful and historic family owned wineries. Located in the Nagambie Lakes region of central Victoria (120kms north of Melbourne), one of the nation's premium viticultural areas. Purchased by the Purbrick family in 1925, Tahbilk is home to 5 generations.

Tahbilk has some 28 hectares of Cabernet Sauvignon planted on the Estate with the oldest vines dating back to 1949. Made utilizing tradition Tahbilk techniques; fermentation takes place in 150-year-old open oak vats and maturation in predominantly French oak for 18 months. Tahbilk Cabernet Sauvignon releases have consistently shown considerable richness and character over time and are considered by many expert to be the best Estate red for long-term cellaring.

Ripe blackcurrant, savoury and minty notes define a varietally expressive wine, finishing with fine-grained tannins that will provide the foundation for added complexity to develop over time. Drink now to 2024/2029.
