Riverhurst Centennial Committee grants applications are available at the Village office and website. The committee has approx. \$21,000 in funds to disperse. Organizations can apply for grants to assist with projects/programs that enhance the community, or for Canada 150 Celebration Events.

The Rural Area Water Association (RAWA) proposed pipeline to Central Butte with service to many farms along the way has been recently voted against by Central Butte council. RAWA is currently reassessing options.

The Village is working toward the mandated effluent drainage system at the South West corner of town and the East slough drainage with our partners MPE Engineering to draw up grant proposals due at the end of January. Our recent drain of the slough produced positive results in some homes on the East side of town who were having water issues in basements. We will be working towards our budget for 2017 at the next council meeting on January 18 at 8:30 am in the Village Square.
