

BYLAW NUMBER 2015-02

A BYLAW TO SET USER FEES

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERHURST IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The list of user fees for the Village of Riverhurst is set out as follows:

A. Disposal Bucket Rates for Village of Riverhurst Rate Payers

i) Sofa/Loveseat/Appliances - \$50.00

ii) Mattress/Box Spring - \$30.00

iii) Table/Chair - \$25.00

iv) Small Item - \$5.00

v) General Refuse Per Pound - \$0.25

B. Disposal Bucket Rates for Non Ratepayers

i) Sofa/Loveseat/Appliances - \$75.00

ii) Mattress/Box Spring - \$45.00

iii) Table/Chair - \$37.50

iv) Small Item - \$7.50

v) General Refuse Per Pound - \$0.40

C. Sewer Reaming Rates in the Village of Riverhurst

i) \$40.00 per hour with a 1 hour minimum charge

ii) \$17.50 per hours for second operator not including the home owner

D. Sewer Reaming Rates outside the Village of Riverhurst

i) \$150.00 per hours with a 1 hour minimum charge

ii) \$50.00 per hour for each additional hour

iii) 17.50 per hours for second operator not including the home owner

E. Non-Sufficient Funds Cheque Penalty

i) The fee for a payment by cheque being returned NSF will be \$50.00.

F. Custom Mowing and Snow Blowing Rates

i) Kubota Mower - \$60.00 per hour

ii) Farmhaul 90 - \$70.00 per hour

iii) Snow Blower - \$80.00 per hour

G. Water and Sewer Connection Materials

i) Water and Sewer Connection Materials (Not Including Water Line and PCV Pipe) - \$850.00

ii) ¾ Inch Plastic Water Line - \$0.65 per foot

iii) 4 Inch PCV Pipe - \$2.35 per foot

iv) Trenching Services will be paid by the Village of Riverhurst and then invoiced to the property owner.

v) If a connection requires a different size of water line or PVC pipe than is listed in this section the cost invoiced to the property owner will be determined by the suppliers invoice.

2. Bylaw Number 2014-09 is hereby repealed.
