

BYLAW NUMBER 2013-10

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERHURST, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

DEFINITIONS

1. For the purpose of his Bylaw the expression:

(A) "dog" means a male or female dog of any age;

(B) "Municipality" means the Village of Riverhurst;

(C) "running at large" means the dog is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor or harbourer of the dog, or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner or occupant of the land and when it is not under control by being:

(i) in direct and continuous charge of a person competent to control it; or

(ii) securely confined within an enclosure; or

(iii) Securely fastened so that it cannot roam at will;

2. Every person within the Village of Riverhurst who owns, possesses, or harbours a dog shall obtain a licence from the Village Office at a sum of \$10.00

3. All licences issued under the provisions of this bylaw shall expire on December 31" following the date of issue.

4. Every person to whom a licence has been issued under this bylaw shall cause his dog to wear a collar to which shall be attached the licence tag issued by the Village of Riverhurst.

5. Every person residing in the Village of Riverhurst, who owns, possesses or harbours a dog, and neglects or refuses to take out a licence therefore shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw and shall be subject to the fines as set out in Appendix A attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

6. A person residing in the Village of Riverhurst who owns, possesses or harbours a dog, and the dog is found to be running at large shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw and shall be subject to the fines as set out in Appendix A attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

7. Bylaw Number 99-8 is hereby repealed.

APPENDIX A

Fine for Neglecting or Refusing to Purchase or Renew Dog License - \$10.00 plus the cost of License

Fines for Dog Running at Large

First Offense - \$50.00

Second Offense - \$100.00

Third Offense - \$200.00

For each additional Offense the fine shall be twice that of the previous fine.
