

BYLAW NUMBER 2013-15

A BYLAW TO CONTROL RECREATIONAL VEHICLES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF RIVERHURST

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERHURST IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the purposes of this bylaw the following definitions apply:

1.1. Recreation Vehicle (RV) means Any vehicle used or constructed in such a way as to enable it to be used as a conveyance upon public streets or highways and includes a self-propelled or non-self-propelled vehicle designed, constructed or reconstructed in such a manner to permit the occupancy thereof as a dwelling or sleeping place for one or more persons notwithstanding that its running gear is removed or that it is jacked up.

1.2. Dwelling means a building or structure or part of a building or structure intended for residential occupancy.

1.3. Building means a structure constructed on, in, or over land and used for the shelter or accommodation of persons, animals, goods, or chattels, and includes any structure covered by a roof supported by walls or columns.

1.4. Structure means anything that is built, constructed or erected, located on the ground, or attached to something located on or in the ground.

1.5. Council Means the Council of the Village of Riverhurst

2. No Recreational Vehicle (RV) shall be used as a primary dwelling or building in the Village of Riverhurst without the approval of Council.

3. No Recreational Vehicle (RV) shall be occupied in the Village of Riverhurst for more than 60 days in a calendar year without the approval of Council.

4. Section 3 does not apply to the Riverhurst Campground.

5. Any Recreational Vehicle (RV) must not be parked within 2 meters of any property line unless the adjoining property is owned by the same person.
