

# BYE BYE BIRDIE CAST REQUIREMENTS

## TEENAGE GIRLS:

ALL TEENAGE GIRLS should plan to wear either DANCE TIGHTS or PANTYHOSE – color can be natural (nude) or light tan. Ankle socks are being supplied as well.

SHOES NEEDED: Saddle shoes, or simple “Ked” sneakers – please ask if you would like to know the color of your costume to match your shoes.

“**Kim MacAfee**” – please supply everything above, as well as a pair of jeans (straight leg – cuffed at hem for on-stage costume change) & a pair of nude character shoes for the “Ed Sullivan Show”.

Wearing your OWN nude leotard under the costumes is a good idea (if you have one). Please do NOT wear brightly colored under garments.

## HAIR STYLES:

TEENS: High ponytail or pigtails is appropriate, or hair curled with headband holding it back from face – see pix



## ADULT WOMEN:

Please supply either DANCE TIGHTS or PANTYHOSE – color can be natural (nude) or light tan.

## SHOES:

Please supply character shoes – if you would like to coordinate color of shoes & costume, please contact us.

ADULTS: Women wore their hair up in a back loose bun or twist, or if shorter it was curled – see pix.



## BYE BYE BIRDIE CAST REQUIREMENTS

### TEENAGE BOYS:

ALL BOYS that are playing TEENS should plan to wear Converse type sneakers, a white undershirt (t-shirt style), and white athletic socks.

### PLEASE SUPPLY:

KHAKI PANTS (NO CARGO PANTS) or JEANS are appropriate. (NOT SKINNY JEANS). As well as a leather belt (ALL SHIRTS WILL BE TUCKED IN).

### In addition:

MARCO G., MASSIMO G. & AUSTIN H. – PLEASE SUPPLY BLACK PANTS, BLACK DRESS SOCKS, AND BLACK DRESS SHOES FOR SCENES IN A QUARTET – “ONE LAST KISS & TALK TO ME”.

“**Conrad Birdie**” – please supply jeans & converse sneakers for Act II Ice House costume.

### ADULT MALES:

Please supply a white t-shirt undershirt (with sleeves), dark dress socks & dress shoes.

### HAIRSTYLES:

TEENS – combed, using a little gel to hold in place – see pix



ADULTS – shorter style, also combed nicely into place – see pix
