## The central aims of this workshop are to:

1. Identify gender bias and socialization as it may affect client/therapist and therapist/supervisor relationships.
2. Identify and differentiate the use of terms that can be used to describe gender identities across a wide spectrum.
3. Conduct a basic assessment of concerns related to gender identity and/or sexual orientation and co-occurrence with other mental health concerns.
4. Describe at least two common relational (transferential or countertransferential) dynamics that may occur in assessment or psychotherapy with trans and nonbinary clients.

Sand is the Clinical Practice Consultant for Northern California Kaiser Permanente, a member of the World Professional Association of Transgender Health's Standards of Care 8 Task Force, and past Chair of the American Psychological Association Committee on Sexual Orientation and Gender Diversity (CSOGD).
