

Day 5 Opening

MC: Good morning everybody! Are you ready for your final day of fun? Today is all about being there for others. Just being there is a form of service! We have a song today about loving others.

Play the Day 5 song: _____ (We used "Lead a Life of Love" *SonSparks*, Track 6)

MC: That was great! We have one more mission today to complete your training as God's secret agents. I believe we have a speaker here today to tell you about today's Daily Mission.

Introduce the speaker for the fifth day: _____ (We did Barry from Samaritans, Inc.)

MC: Isn't that a great mission? And we will all help them today in the Daily Mission Station.

Speaking about missions, I wonder what OOO is up to today.

Skit

Day 5 Morning Skit

OOO: Wow! I really love talking to the Director. The *insert name or acronym of Day 4 religious organization: _____ (ex: SF Sisterhood) * is so smart to do all of the prayer they do. I even talked to some of them, and they said that with prayer, you could also talk with the Director's MOTHER! Isn't that awesome? I wonder if she makes Peanut butter and jelly sandwiches too. They called this special prayer the Hail Mary, which is apparently more than just a football play. And I'm really glad that I don't have to carry that darn radio everywhere. I've done a really good job staying under the radar... being secretive and such.

ABC: (In a disguise) Lost, lost, lost... (Walking across toward OOO) All kinds of lost

OOO: What's lost? Maybe I can help you find it with my Telescope 10,000 (Pulls out a toy telescope) ... Or, wait, are YOU lost? I'll bet my Supermap 12,000 can get you back to where you need to go! (Pulls out a road atlas)

ABC: No, no. That's okay. I've lost something that can't be found.

OOO: Oh no, you can find ANYTHING with the Telescope 10,000.

ABC: No. I'm just lonely, I guess. I've lost the ability to enjoy life and have fun. I don't know what to do.

OOO: What you need is a snack. This Supermap 12000 says that the nearest snack is... (Points, squints) that tiny little dot there. Boy, why is everything so small? (Sees ABC's sad face) Well, how can I help? This Supermap 12000 isn't being very helpful.

ABC: Well... I could use somebody to talk to. Do you have time to talk to a stranger like me?

OOO: Well, I have a yoga class at 11... but sure! I could be a friend. So... umm... tell me about yourself. What's your favorite vegetable?

ABC: My favorite vegetable? (Begins to discard disguise) OOO, what kind of question is that?

OOO: Wait, without that eyepatch, (etc.) you look like a secret agent!

ABC: Yes OOO. I had to go undercover to give you your final test as a trainee. And I think you just passed.

OOO: (Hyperventilating, squeaky, excited voice) I... I did?

ABC: Certainly. You took the time to help someone in need, making their day better. By simply being a caring friend, you completed a mission of service.

OOO: (More extreme than before) I did?

ABC: The Director thinks so. I, Agent ABC, am proud to promote you to the official status of Secret Agent. (OOO faints) Oh boy. Get up OOO!

OOO: (Still dazed) Just five more minutes!

ABC: Well, while you're down there, let me give you the “new agent debriefing.” As I said before, I'm agent ABC. It stands for “Always Be Caring.” The Director often has me promote Agents to remind them of this, but you already have been caring to me, and I thank you.

OOO: (Dazed, and a little shocked) You are so welcome

ABC: Now, a little more info about being an agent. You are responsible to complete the supreme mission, but also to complete the Director’s mission: Make Another’s Day. That's why he's called Director MAD.

OOO: (Wobbly voice, pathetic) I KNEW that He wasn't actually mad! I knew it!

ABC: Are you sure you can do this? You've been on the ground for a long time.

OOO: Yes sir! (Stands up suddenly) I won't let you, or the Director, down.

ABC: (Smiling) Good. Now come, secret agent. It's time to take the skills you've learned to the others who need it.

OOO: WOOHOO! I'M A REAL SECRET AGENT!

Day 5 Opening (continued)

MC: Wow, OOO is a secret agent! He finally learned the most important part of service: love! That reminds me of today's memory verse. It comes from 1 Corinthians 16:14. "Your every act should be done with love." Our virtues from the ladder of faith are very similar. They are "mutual affection" and "love." Loving others is so important that it's in the bible a lot! God wants us to help others because we care about them. Actually, the word "charity" means love! So just be caring about others, just like Agent ABC and OOO, we can be good secret agents for God. Let's pray. Lord, please guide us today as we go throughout bible camp. Help us to learn how to care about others and help others in your name. Amen. (Optional group pictures: *Now we need to take a group picture. Can I have the adults help organize their groups? We will start with the campers and the teens and adults will join them after that.*)

Bible Story Station (Recon)

The Parable of the Good Samaritan: Luke 10:29-37

Objective:

During this lesson, campers will learn about brotherly love and kindness through the story of the Good Samaritan.

Who is a "Good Samaritan" who has been in the news lately? How have they shown God's love through their actions?

Who is someone you know that is a "Good Samaritan"? How does this person help others?

How can we be a "Good Samaritan" to those around us? What can we do to help others?

How does being a "Good Samaritan" make you feel?

We used these questions to make a game show for the campers. It kept with the theme of television shows from the News Report skit and made answering the questions fun for the kids.

Thumbprint Art


What you'll need:

We can talk to God whenever we want in prayer, and our Supreme Mission is to be in Heaven with God forever. Let's celebrate with some songs.
