

## TMNT Gloves for Kids by Auburn Elephant



### *Supplies Needed:*

Worsted Weight Yarn in Dk Green, Red, Blue, Purple, and Orange

Tapestry Needle

H Hook

### *Stitches Used:*

[Ch-Chain](#)

SS-Slip Stitch

[SC-Single Crochet](#)

[HDC-Half Double Crochet](#)

[FHDC-Foundation Half Double Crochet](#)

DEC- Half Double Crochet Decrease

### *Start with the Cuff*

**1)** CH 9, SC in 2nd chain from hook, SC 7 across, Ch 1, turn (8)

**2-22)** In BLO SC across, Ch 1, turn (8)

SS to the beginning chain to make a cuff, turn the cuff inside out so that the slip stitch seam is on the inside. Ch 1 (Chains do not count as stitches.)

- 1) (going evenly around the edge of the cuff) 2SC, SC 10, 2SC, SC 10, Join to top of 1st SC, Ch 1 (24)
- 2) HDC 2, DEC, HDC 10, DEC, HDC 8. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch 1 (22)
- 3-5) HDC around. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch 1 (22)
- 6) HDC 2, 2HDC, HDC 10, 2HDC, HDC 8. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch 1 (24)
- 7) HDC 3, 2HDC, HDC 11, 2HDC, HDC 8. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch 1 (26)
- 8-LEFT) HDC 6, CH 3, SKIP 5, HDC 15. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch 1 (21 HDC, 3 CH)
- 8-RIGHT) HDC 15, CH 3, SKIP 5, HDC 6. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch 1 (21 HDC, 3 CH)
- 9-LEFT) HDC 6, HDC 3 across CH space, HDC 15. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch 1 (24)
- 9-RIGHT) HDC 15, HDC 3 across CH space, HDC 6. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch 1 (24)
- 10-11) HDC around. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch 1 (24)
- 12) HDC 2, SKIP 12, HDC 10. Join with SS to top of 1st HDC, Ch1 (12 HDC, 12 unworked stitches)
- 13) HDC around. Join with SS to 1st HDC. (12)

Finish Off, Weave in Ends

**12B)** Join yarn to unworked stitches, HDC around. Join with SS to 1st HDC, Ch 1 (12)

**13B)** HDC around. Join with SS to 1st HDC. (12)

Finish Off. Weave in Ends. *(If you notice a significant gap between the two "fingers" you can use the tail of yarn to stitch it closed.)*

## **WRIST TIE**

1) FHDC 45 (enough to go around the glove twice) Ch 1, turn

2) HDC across. (24) Leave a long tail for sewing.

Wrap the tie around the wrist of the glove (at the top of the cuff) and sew into place.

Make a pair and then get ready for some Cowabunga action!
