



Mortgage Rates Up to 4-Year High



After mostly stagnant activity levels in recent weeks, mortgage rates are back on the move. The 30-year fixed-rate mortgage rose to its highest level since January 2014 this week, also seeing its largest weekly increase since February of this year, Freddie Mac reports.

Average mortgage rates were higher across the board too, posting weekly increases to not only the 30-year fixed-rate mortgage but also to 15-year and 5-year hybrid adjustable-rate mortgages.

Freddie Mac reports the following national averages in mortgage rates for the week ending April 19:

- **30-year fixed-rate mortgages:** averaged 4.47 percent, with an average 0.5 point, rising from last week's 4.42 percent average. Last year at this time, 30-year rates averaged 3.97 percent.
- **15-year fixed-rate mortgages:** averaged 3.94 percent, with an average 0.4 point, rising from last week's 3.87 percent average. A year ago, 15-year rates averaged 3.23 percent.
- **5-year hybrid adjustable-rate mortgages:** averaged 3.67 percent, with an average 0.3 point, increasing from last week's 3.61 percent average. A year ago, 5-year ARMs averaged 3.10 percent.

Email Scams! DO NOT CLICK ON THEM!

Members should be aware of a suspicious email being deployed with the subject line: "ANNUAL REPORT TO ALL MEMBERS OF NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTOR (NAR)" from the email address presidentceo@usa.com (link sends e-mail). Please note that official NAR emails will come from a realtor.org or realtors.org email address and include proper branding, messaging, contact information and opt-out provisions. NAR has already reached out to the domain provider to report this issue. Do not click on any links within this email.

The National Association of REALTORS® urges its members and state and local REALTOR® associations to be on high alert for email and online fraud.

ALSO: MOVOTO LEAD CONTACT—SUNDAY'S SCAM!

The easiest way to check for a scam email is to check the sender's email address behind the obvious place, usually in parentheses or brackets, and see that the "@" information matches the assumed sender email listed. Many times, the domain listed is NOT related to the email sender's address, or is misspelled to re-route to the scammer's address. If you didn't subscribe to a service, don't click until you read the entire message carefully, and NEVER send contact or financial info until you are absolutely sure of the sender.




