PRIEST RETIREMENT

THE DEDICATED PRIESTS who served us in the past now deserve to live out their retirement years in dignity. **St. William has been assessed \$6,779** and **IHM has been assessed \$6,269** for the priests' retirement and benefit plans. This amount is slightly less than two times the regular weekend offertory. This second collection will take place the weekend of September 30 and October 1st. 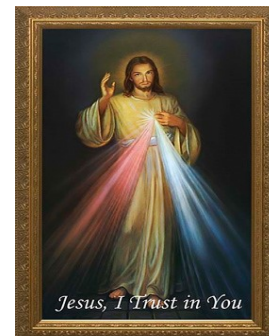
