A NOTE FROM FR. ALEX. Two years ago, the Diocese of Charlotte established St. Joseph College Seminary where, to date, we have 16 seminarians in formation, with 8 more set to begin studies in the fall of 2018. We plan to build a permanent home for the Seminary on 86 acres of land near Belmont Abbey, where the young men will obtain undergraduate degrees. So far \$4.7million has been given, with approximately \$15 million needed to complete the first phase of the 2 phase plan.
