THOMPSON GAS GIVE BACK PROGRAM is in full swing. As you know, this program has been in place for several years in our Parish and it is a win-win for both the consumer and our Parish. Preseason pricing this year is \$1.799 per gallon if you fill up before August 31st. Last year Thompson Gas tithed back 5.5 cents for each gallon consumed by the Church and 9.5 cents for each gallon consumed by our members: the total give back to the Parish for the 2016-2017 campaign was \$1,224.00.
