THOMPSON GAS GIVE BACK PROGRAM DEADLINE. Preseason pricing this year is \$1.799 per gallon if you fill up before August 31st. Last year Thompson Gas tithed back 5.5 cents for each gallon consumed by the Church and 9.5 cents for each gallon consumed by our members: the total give back to the Parish for the 2016-2017 campaign was \$1,224.00.
