

***** INSTRUCTION SHEET FOR BIBLE LESSONS *****

- A. The Bible verses used in this study are taken from the King James Version of the Bible, translated out of the original tongues with the former translation diligently compared and revised.
- B. Before doing each lesson, take time to ask God to open your understanding and show you the truth.
- C. For the best results, <u>do only one lesson each day</u>. Meditate on each day's lesson. (There are four weeks of lessons per book)
- D. Keep in mind that these lessons are based on what the Bible says and not on man's opinion.
- E. These lessons are designed to help you to know the truth, to know the Lord in a personal way, and to trust what the Bible says and teaches you.
- F. Remember, it is not what you, I, or any preacher says, but what the Bible says.
- G. You must learn to stand on what the Bible says to "study to show yourself approved unto God, workman that needed not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (II Timothy 2:15).
- H. Who wrote the Bible? (II Peter 1:21)
- I. All Scripture is inspired by God (II Timothy 3:16).
- J. Regardless of what man says, the believer (Christian) has direct access to the throne of God and is responsible directly to God. This access is through Jesus Christ and Him only (I Timothy 2:5).
- K. These studies are to help you have peace of mind (Isaiah 26:3-4).
- L. These studies will help you know if you are going to Heaven or Hell (Romans 10:13).
- M. These lessons will help you with assurance and security; these are not the same. The securing of the believer is God's work; It is a part of God's great work of Salvation depending solely upon His infinite grace. Assurance is the believer's acceptance of the security provided for him in Christ; It is the result of the human soul resting in what God has promised in His Word to accomplish. This is why it is important to know what the Bible says (I John 5:11-13).

This weeks verse to memorize: Proverbs 3:5-6

Trust in the Lord with all thine heart, and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths.

Introduction:

The letter to the Ephesians is concerned, first of all, with God's plan "That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him" (1:10). It is also an appeal to God's people to live out the meaning of this great plan for the unity of the whole human race through oneness with Jesus Christ.

In the first part of Ephesians, the Bible develops the theme of unity by speaking of the way in which God the Father has chosen His people, how they are forgiven and set free from their sins through Jesus Christ the Son, and how God's great promise is guaranteed by the Holy Spirit. In the second part, He appeals to us to live in such a way that our oneness in Christ may become real in our lives. Several figures of speech are used to show the oneness of God's people in union with Christ: the church is like a body, with Christ as the head; or, like a building, with Christ as the cornerstone; or, like a wife, with Christ as the husband. This letter rises to great heights of expression as the Holy Spirit is moved by the thought of God's grace in Christ.

Everything is seen in the light of Christ's love, sacrifice, forgiveness, grace, and purity.

The first two verses of Ephesians chapter 1 are greetings from the one who wrote this book. It was written by Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ. How is Paul writing this book?
From "the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who hath" what?
Explain the meaning of the statement in verse 3: "Who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessing in heavenly places in Christ."

This weeks verse to memorize: Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all thine heart, and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths.
"According as He (God) hath chosen us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be" what?
As you can see, God chose us. The question is: Did you and I choose Him? As John 3:16 tells us, "God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son." The last part of this verse says, "that whosoever <u>believeth</u> in Him (this is our part) should not perish, but have everlasting life." Romans 10:13 says, "For whosoever shall <u>call</u> (this is our part) upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." The decision is up to you. God chose you; now, will you choose Him?
"Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children"; how?
"According to the good pleasure of" whose will?
This verse tells us plainly that by God's will, He gave Jesus, His only Son, to pay the price for us to be saved and to be adopted as one of God's children, if we only accept Him.
"To the praise of the glory of His grace, wherein He hath made us accepted" in the what?
Verse 6 can be read this way: Let us praise God for His glorious grace, for the free gift He gave us in His dear Son.
"In whom (Jesus) we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins"; how?
Never let anyone tell you there is any other way to go to Heaven other than what verse 7 tell us so plainly; we are redeemed through His blood. Notice the word SINS — not just one sin, but many. THERE IS NO OTHER WAY TO BE SAVED BUT THROUGH THE BLOOD OF JESUS THAT WAS SHED ON THE CROSS.
