YOUTH "PERMISSION SLIP" AND ADULT/YOUTH INFO SHEET

The Schurr High School Music Boosters are privileged to work with Sodexo Magic at the Rose Bowl for fundraising purposes. In order to keep this business relationship working, we would like to inform volunteers of some requirements:

Current Students, 16 and over, can raise funds for Band, Color Guard, Drill Team and Orchestra.

Before any **STUDENT** can participate in volunteering at the Rose Bowl, the student and parent/guardian must first read and sign this agreement form. **This form is now required for all students** regardless if they have worked a Rose Bowl event in the past.

Students who are dropped off at the meeting site (usually Schurr HS) for call time will carpool to the Rose Bowl with another parent/driver. The parent/driver they ride to the Rose Bowl with, will be the **same person** the student leaves the Rose Bowl with, **unless permission to leave with another driver is granted by the "original driver"**. The "original driver" is responsible for every passenger in their car. It is recommended that each driver get the cell numbers of each person in their car in case they are separated at the Rose Bowl.

No Student is allowed to leave the Rose Bowl premises (inside or out) for any reason; alone, with another minor or another adult. Permission must always be given by the Lead Organizer before leaving.

In the event of a car accident where the driver is NOT at fault, driver assumes no legal responsibility for student(s) in the vehicle.

Rose Bowl events are normally long days, running anywhere from 10-15 hours. A driver may have multiple students to drive back to the meeting site and some events (e.g. Concerts) can be as late as 2 a.m. The driver will not be allowed to leave the Rose Bowl until all passengers are accounted for.

Each student will need to provide an emergency contact phone number in the event an emergency may arise, or if a student should become sick, a parent or guardian would need to pick up the student at the Rose Bowl.

Alcohol and Minors:

In the event that a concert and/or game serves alcohol, it is the policy of Sodexo and Schurr High Music Boosters, that all students under the age of 18 remain out of the front of the "perm". This is a rule that will be taken very serious as our contract with Sodexo could be
