Registration Timeline

<u>March 18</u>: Registration Drop Off from 5:30pm-6:30pm @ Dick's Sporting Goods Chapel Hills. (Roster, Payment, and Team Registration forms need to be submitted by March 18. No exceptions). Any team who cannot make the drop-off, can mail in their registration materials, but they must be postmarked no later than March 15.

<u>March 31:</u> In-person mandatory coaches meet at Sunday March 31 at 5:00pm at Coronado High School (large gym). Schedules will be distributed at this time.

April 2: Schedules posted online (coaches will have them in-hand Sunday March 31).

April 5/6/7: Games Begin

May 17/18/19: End of the Season Tournament (brackets posted online by Thursday May 9.

Registration Checklist

5) Once a year, all coaches must complete the online Concussion in Sports training (free) and print (or scan an e-mail) the certificate of completion. The course can be found here: <u>http://nfhslearn.com/courses/61037</u>

6) If your team is located 45 minutes outside of Colorado Springs, please contact SoCo. It is the coaches' responsibility to contact SoCo if a team is traveling far distances to place in the league (for scheduling purposes).

7) Attend the mandatory coaches meet at Sunday March 31 at 5:00pm at Coronado High School (large gym). Schedules and coaches' gifts will be distributed at this time.

Cost and Payment:

Payment is due at the time of registration by the coach. The cost is \$105/per-player and all teams must have a minimum of 8 players to participate. <u>SoCo does not accept credit cards.</u> Players can still add to teams after the team registration deadline, but teams will not be able to participate without payment for 8 players on March 18⁻ There is no admission fee for any regular season games for parents or spectators.

Roster notes/rules

- Parent signatures are required for all participants. The waiver is on the next sheet.
- Players may play up one age division, but cannot play down (unless approved by SoCo). Players are eligible for only one roster in each age division. If a player participates in two age divisions, he/she must be officially registered for each division and must have paid for both teams.
- The league has the discretion to allow an approved player to play down an age division under very specific circumstances. If this occurs, the player must be approved by the league before the roster is submitted. After league play begins, SoCo has the right to remove this player from the team if SoCo believes the player is too advanced to play in the lower division. Again, the circumstances for approval will be extremely specific scenarios such as:
 - A child started school at an early age (age 4)
 - o A child was advanced a grade level due to academic achievement or prowess
- Teams are gender specific.
