Registration Timeline

March 17 (5:00pm MST): The registration deadline is March 17 at 5:00pm MST. Registration and payment must be received by 5:00pm on the 17. Registration is online only.

<u>March 30 (5:30pm):</u> In-person mandatory Rookie coaches meeting on Monday, March 30 at 5:30 pm at Red Leg Brewing Company (4630 Forge Rd, Colorado Springs). Veteran coaches are not required to attend and will do an online training. Coaches in attendance can turn in their concussion certificate and wavier form at this time. April 1: The Regular Season SoCo Schedule will be put online.

April 3,4,5: Games Begin.

May 1,2,3: End of the Season Tournament (brackets posted online by the April 28 at 12:00pm).

<u>Snow Makeup Weekend</u>: May 8,9,10 (if weather causes us to cancel any of the games in the five weekends above, we will make every effort to reschedule them in the scheduled five week footprint. These dates will be backup for worst case scenarios).

Cost and Payment:

The cost per team is \$995. Teams cannot have more than 12 players on their team. Payment is due with the online registration by 5:00pm on March 17, 2020 via credit card. Please contact Megan Leatham (SoCoHoops.Megan@gmail.com) if you would prefer to pay with a check or cash. Players can still be added to team rosters after the registration deadline, but teams will not be able to participate without payment. There is no admission fee for any regular season games for parents or spectators.

Divisions

There is a boy's division and a girl's division for the following grade division (currently enrolled):

4th/5th Grade 6th Grade 7th Grade 8th Grade

- For the 4th/5th division, teams can have players from the grade levels specified. For the 6th, 7th, and 8th grade divisions, teams are grade specific (players can play up a grade level, but not down).
- Should the number of teams registered for any one division reach 12-14+ teams; the division will likely be split into a *Gold Division* (upper) and a *Silver Division* (lower). The final decision whether or not to split a division will be up to the SoCo staff. Teams are gender specific.
- We ask that competitive teams, who have been consistently dominant in their age group, consider playing up a division to create a more even playing environment for all teams involved.
- Players are only eligible for one roster per division. A player may participate in more than one division (at a higher level and/or if the division splits into Gold and Silver). In such a situation, the player assumes the risk of any scheduling conflict. Teams are gender specific.

Games:

All spring games will be tipped-off during the following timeslots:

Friday: 6:00pm-9:00pmSaturday: 9:00am-9:00pmSunday: 12:00pm-7:00pm

In consideration of family planning, all schedules will be given out prior to the first game and are established for the remainder of the season. Games consist of two (2) twenty-minute halves, modified running clock. Adjusted Colorado High School rules govern play. Each team will be scheduled for eight games. The league will be topped off with an end of season single elimination tournament. Practice facilities/times are the responsibility of the coach. Each team is responsible to provide one representative at the scorer's table for each game.
