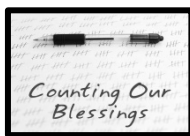


*"I want to let God take control of my life."

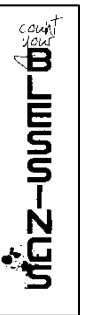

The purpose of the HIT program is to allow teens to get experience in all areas of camp. Each HIT raised his/her own money to come to camp.

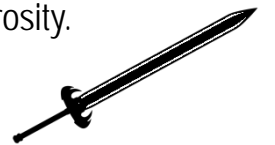

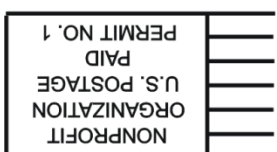
