Our girls are growing up in a not-so-kid-friendly world. Family breakdowns, absent fathers, the proliferation of pornography, unhealthy role models, a predatory and bullying atmosphere online, the sexualization of media and constant attacks on their self-image from every direction leave them confused, insecure and feeling very much alone.

Since 2011 we have been using outdoor recreation, adventure programming, community service & community partnerships to speak positively into girls' lives, to help them discover & celebrate their uniqueness and develop the emotional intelligence, confidence and resilience to successfully battle the negative influences in their lives. Within a Christian framework, we combine day-camp style weeks, drop-in events & multi-day trips to expose girls to new challenges, provide settings for them to share & address critical issues in their lives, help them believe in themselves & the unique gifts they bring to the world, and to discover their power, possibility & potential.
