He's been a great minister for the New Port Richey congregation and its outreach to a largely homeless population.

Last fall, it was announced that Jerome was in dire need of a liver transplant. This is a man who has given countless hours to the Lord and to His flock in New Port Richey—a man who sweeps floors, preaches sermons and simply loves on his congregation.
