I just finished reading a wonderful new book entitled "Eat Pray Love" written by Elizabeth Gilbert (hit #1 on the New York Times Bestseller list) and I recommend it highly. In light of my own Spiritual ADD, I found the author's account of her year-long trek through three countries and the emotional/religious interplay of each to be mesmerizing. Ms. Gilbert echoed my own sentiments in the following excerpts:

Your job, then, should you choose to accept it, is to keep searching for the metaphors, rituals, and teachers that will help you move ever closer to divinity. The Yogic scriptures say that God responds to the sacred prayers and efforts of human beings in any way whatsoever that mortals choose to worship - just so long as those prayers are sincere. As one line from the Upanishads suggests: "People follow different paths, straight or crooked, according to their temperament, depending on which they consider best or most appropriate - and all reach You, just as rivers enter the ocean." What I'm seeing in some of my friends, though, as they are aging, is a longing to have something to believe in. But this longing chafes against any number of obstacles, including their intellect and common sense. Despite all their intellect, though, these people still live in a world that careens about in a series of wild and devastating and completely

nonsensical lurches. Great and horrible experiences of either suffering or joy occur in the lives of all these people, just as with the rest of us, and these mega-experiences tend to make us long for a spiritual context in which to express either lament or gratitude, or to seek understanding. The problem is - what to worship, whom to pray to? The Hopi Indians thought that the world's religions each contained one spiritual thread, and that these threads are always seeking each other, wanting to join. When all the threads are finally woven together they will form a rope that will pull us out of this dark cycle of history and into the next realm. More contemporarily, the Dalai Lama has repeated the same idea, assuring his Western students repeatedly that they needn't become Tibetan Buddhists in order to be his pupils. But doesn't that make sense? That the infinite would be, indeed ... infinite? That even the most holy amongst us would only be able to see scattered pieces of the eternal picture at any given time? And that maybe if we could collect those pieces and compare them, a story about God would begin to emerge that resembles and includes everyone? And isn't our individual longing for transcendence all just part of this larger human search for divinity? Don't we each have the right to not stop seeking until we get as close the source of wonder as possible? That's me in the corner, in other words. That's me in the spotlight. Choosing my religion.

Ear candling originated centuries ago by the Egyptians as a natural medicinal ear remedy. Some used it in their Spiritual practice to assist them in hearing God better. It spread to Greece, China and today ear candling is practiced around the world. There is no pain to the person receiving this highly successful remedy. It helps with clogged sinuses and pressure, sore throat, swimmer's ear, allergies and hearing improvement. A specially-made hollow candle is used. The top of the candle is lit and the base of the candle is gently placed in the ear. The procedure takes about 15 minutes for each ear, so allow for a 30 minute treatment.

Talisman's Ear Candling practitioner is Mary. Her bio is as follows:

I was born in Connecticut in 1955. I was sensitive as a child and could see fairies, spirits and feel the energies of those (humans/animals) around me. Lucky for me my parents allowed my gifts to grow when I began to predict things that came to fruition for the family. With a strong desire to work as a medium and spiritual consultant I moved to Salem, Ma., and for six months, gave intuitive readings and worked on two different murder cases. I have been back here in Connecticut for three years and continue my life's adventure as a Servant and Messenger of the light.

The Astrology Zone - by Alethea

Hi folks! Just a friendly "head's up" that Mercury will be retrograde later this month, from August 20th - September 12th. Mercury is the planet of communication, so choose your words carefully during this time and make sure to really spell things out with others so that there is no room left for misinterpretation.
