Merry Greetings!

For many of us, October ushers in our favorite time of year and one of our most beloved celebrations - Samhain (otherwise known as Halloween). This year at Talisman, we've decided to do things a bit differently. Because Halloween falls on a Friday, we know most of you will rush home from work in order to be out with your kids or home, handing out candy. And certainly, we'll have treats at the shop for anyone who wants to come by on the 31st. But our festivities will take place on Saturday, November 1st (10 am - 8 pm) when we will remember our beloved who have passed from us on "Los Dias de los Muertos" The Day of the Dead. In Mexico, the celebration lasts from October 27 through November 2, so we will incorporate different aspects of the tradition into a single day at Talisman. We will begin by setting up an altar in the front window, and now invite all of you to bring pictures of your beloved dead - human and pet - along with an index card sized note about the deceased. It is traditional to have a flower-strewn path from the front door to the altar as an invitation for the dead to come and visit. The purpose of Los Dias de los Muertos is to heal the sorrow of loss through active engagement, festivities, and remembrance. In Mexico, families set up picnics on the graves of family members and talk about them as they eat and drink their favorite foods. It is a way of keeping their memory alive and is not viewed as ghoulish or macabre.

Throughout Saturday the 1st, we will have refreshments and activities. Many of us are struggling through difficult financial times so there will be no charge. We are hoping this day will prove to be an opportunity for our community to come together. Bring your drum and take part in a drum circle at 11:30-12:00 and again at 7:00-7:30. Downstairs, we will set up a psychomantium which will be available in 10 minute increments (longer if no one is waiting!) on both Friday and Saturday. A psychomantium is an ancient form of mirror-gazing that has been popularized by Dr. Raymond Moody, MD. It has its roots in the Oracles of ancient Greece. Dr. Moody authored the 1981 book Life After Death and used the psychomantium in his research trialing 300 subjects. Dr. Moody viewed the room as a therapeutic tool to heal grief and bring insight. So, what are we talking about? A small dark curtained area containing a chair which faces a long mirror. A strobe light helps the brain waves to quickly enter into a meditative state. Before entering "the booth" you spend time focusing your thoughts on the one you wish to contact. You can hold an article of their clothing or other personal item while sitting in the chair facing the mirror. The Victorians, with their love of mysticism, constructed entire mirrored rooms which were used as psychomantiums. You may wish to "google" for more information beforehand!
