

Senior Mrs. Lonoke County Fair Queen

Competition rules

Saturday September 16, 2017

Deadline September 1, 2017

Rules

1. The Senior Mrs. Lonoke County Fair Queen must be 61 years old or older.
2. Applicant must be married or widowed.
3. Applicant must have been born a female and a resident of Lonoke County and must have resided there for at least six months prior to her entering the Senior Mrs. Lonoke County Fair Queen competition.
4. Applicant will continue to be a person of good moral character, affirms that she has not committed and will not commit any act inconsistent with the highest standards of public morals and conventions, or that will reflect unfavorably on the Senior Mrs. Lonoke County Fair Queen Competition, its representatives and sponsors. She will not willingly appear in provocation and sexually explicit photographs for any film or publication prior to, during the competition, or during her reign as Senior Mrs. Lonoke County Fair Queen.
5. Applicant agrees to look solely to the Lonoke County Fair Pageant Director/Superintendent or Fair Board with respects to all matters relating to the Senior Mrs. Lonoke County Fair Queen competition.

Entry Forms

Contestant must complete the entry form and return it to the Lonoke County Fair and Livestock, no later than September 1, 2017. The \$50 entry fee must be with the entry form. Entry forms received without entry fee will not be accepted.

Senior Mrs. Fair Queen duties

Our Senior Mrs. Lonoke County Fair Queen will be expected to make at least three appearances wearing her crown and sash to the Lonoke County Fair to greet visitors for no less than one hour (time and day to be approved by director). Queen will, when asked to, assist with handing out awards in the livestock and exhibit areas. She will ride in the Lonoke County Fair Parade, and the Arkansas State Fair Parade. She will also help promote the Lonoke County Fair and Livestock association throughout the year by volunteering if a situation arises and she is asked to do so on behalf of the fair.

Rehearsal

Rehearsal will be the evening before the pageant. We will begin promptly at 7pm and should be finished by 8pm. We will be having a parade of contestants at the beginning of pageant Saturday and you will want to know what to do, so please try to attend this rehearsal. Rehearsal is closed to the public.

Competition Clothing

Each contestant will have a private interview with the judges and will be assessed individually and comparatively in Fair Attire an Evening Gown competition. Contestants will need the following clothing:

Rehearsal

Since the rehearsal is closed to the public, contestants are free to wear comfortable clothing, hair in curlers and no makeup if desired. We recommend the contestants rehearse in the same shoes they will wear in each phase of competition.

Private Interview

Dress or Suit, Jewelry and shoes of choice - no hats, gloves or purses.

Fair Attire

Something you would wear to the fair or rodeo.

Evening Gown

Evening gown of choice. Jewelry and accessories should be tasteful and compliment the gown. High-heeled shoes are recommended, but not required.

Interview

The interview will account for 50% of a contestant's total score. All interviews will be five minutes long and will be timed and monitored. Judges are instructed to avoid current affairs and religious or political questions. The judges and contestants are not allowed to shake hands or have any physical contact.

Fair Attire

Fair Attire will account for 15% of a contestant's total score. Over all first impression, stage presence, and confidence are also included in the judging.

Evening Gown

Evening gown competition will account for 35% of a contestant's total score. Judging will be based on overall first impression, beauty, stage presence, personality, grace, charm, walk, appropriateness of evening gown and composite appearance. Each contestant will be asked an on stage question and will be allowed a maximum of 20 seconds for their extemporaneous response, her ability to answer confidently, as well as her tone of voice, will be included in the Evening Gown score. Judges are instructed not to judge the gown but to judge the contestant in the gown.

Dressing and Backstage

The Lonoke County Fair and Livestock Show Association is not responsible for loss or damage to clothing or other personal items left in the dressing room or other areas. Contestants and fair officials only are allowed back stage at any time. Absolutely NO CELL PHONES!

Judging

The judges will be appointed by the Lonoke County Fair and Livestock Association. They will be persons well qualified to judge a competition of this kind. Their decision will be final. Critiques will not be provided to anyone, nor will any contestant, or any representative of a contestant, be allowed to approach the judges at any time.

The County Contest Director and or County Fair Management of the Lonoke County Fair and Livestock Association reserve the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with, or incident to the contest, and the right to amend or add to these rules as their judgment may determine. Any contestant who fails to abide by any of the above rules can be disqualified from the competition by the County Contest Director and or County Fair Management.
