

GOATS

There will be the following division for exhibitors:

Pee Wee (ages 3-8), Junior (Ages 9-19) and Open. Pee Wee Showman who want more experience or want to show for Premium Points may enter the Open Division.

General Rules:

- A. **Pre-registration of entries by Sept. 1** (use online entry www.lonokecountyfair.com).
- B. Pen space is limited and will be pre-assigned. All must check-in before being penned, tattoos will be checked at random.
- C. Competition is open to all Lonoke County Residents.
- D. Open Division entry fee is \$2.50 per head. Junior & Pee Wee Division requires no entry fee.
- E. Both registered and grade goats may be shown. Registered goats must have registration paper and legible tattoos. Grade Does must be representative of a recognized breed within its division and must have identifying ear tags or tattoos.
- F. No exhibitor may enter more than two entries per class with exception of the Specialty Classes. Only One entry per class for the Specialty Classes
- G. No goat may be shown in more than one division.
- H. Three (3) goats will constitute a breed show. All breeds entered with less than 3 head will show under All Other Purebreds (AOP).
- I. All Goats must meet Arkansas Health Regulations, no apparent abscesses, upper respiratory, sore mouth, ringworm or foot conditions will be allowed on the grounds.
- J. No tack in the aisle.
- K. NO SHAVING OR DRENCHING ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.**
- L. No Premium money will be issued until pen area is cleaned and checked by superintendents.
- M. All Goats over 6 months on Sept. 1, MUST HAVE COMPLETED REGISTRATION PAPERS. White applications for registration will be accepted for those less than 6 months of age.
- N. Premium points will be awarded in the Open and Junior Division.

BREEDING (REGISTERED) MEAT GOATS

- a) Meat Goat horns must be tipped
- b) Bucks will be allowed up to 1 year in Meat Goat Division. Bucks MUST be registered.
- c) Registered Meat Goats will be considered Breeding Meat Goats (**This Does Not included "Market" Animals**)
- d) Breeds: Boer, Kiko, Myotonic, Spanish (3 animals constitute a breed show) Show Order will be by breed as listed.

- g) Goats will be weighed and classes determined after weigh-in
- h) Minimum weight is 25 lbs.
- i) Entry form shows Pre-registration deadline
- j) Exhibitors must live and go to school in Lonoke County or in North Pulaski County (those living North of the Arkansas River).

Special Rules:

- a) Specialty Classes will be held by breed at the end of each breed judging (Only one entry per class)
- b) Dairy Herd - all Does **MUST** currently be in Milk
- c) No doe shown in the breed dairy herd classes may be shown again in the Mixed Dairy Herd.
- d) No horns allowed in the Dairy Division.
- e) No bucks may be shown in the Dairy Division.
- f) Any Doe 24 months and over must have freshened.
- g) Show order will be by breed as listed above.

- e) Exhibitor must have a display about goats.
- f) Prize ribbons, also \$25 prize paid by Arkansas Goat Producer's Association.
