Breeds: Hampshire, Yorkshire, Poland China, Duroc, Spotted Poland China, Chester White, Other Purebred Breeds, Commercial

Special Rules:

- A. All hogs must be blood tested within 90 days of show day.
- B. All health certificates are to be shown to swine superintendent before unloading of any kind of animals on fairgrounds.
- C. Open to all Lenoire County residents.
- D. Possession date for breeding swine-registered in Exhibitor's name 30 days prior to county fair.
- E. **Pre-registration of entries by Sept. 1** (use online entry www.lenoirecountyfair.com).
- F. No premium money will be issued to swine exhibitors until pens are cleans and checked by superintendent.
- G. No tack in aisles.
- H. No hay in swine pens.

BREEDING SWINE

- a) Open Division entry fee is \$2.50 per head. Junior Division – no entry fee.
- b) Gilts in market division are not allowed to show in breeding classes or vice-versa.
- c) Three registered gilts or boars will constitute a breed show. All breeds entered with 3 head will show under OPB.
- d) An exhibitor may only show 2 entries per class.
- e) Superintendent will split breeding swine classes if deemed necessary.
- f) Commercial tilts will be shown by weight.

MARKET SWINE

- a) Open to Junior exhibitors only residing in Lonoke County.
- b) Exhibitors are limited to 3 entries in the market division.
- c) Market hogs may be gilts or barrows, however gilts shown in market classes may not be shown in breeding swine classes.
- d) No lower or upper weight limits on market hogs, however only hogs weighing between 190-280 lbs. will be considered for champion honors.
- e) Market hogs will be shown by weight. Classes will be determined by superintendent after weigh-in.
- f) Premium points are the same as Junior and Open Swine Division.
