Breeds: Ayrshire, Guernsey, Jersey, Holstein, Brown Swiss, Milking Shorthorn, Other

- A. Non-Registered & Registered animals are allowed in Pee Wee and Junior divisions. Registered animals only in Open Division.
- B. Competitions open to all Lonoke County residents.
- C. Any animal not halter broken will be disqualified.
- D. **Pre-registration of entries by Sept. 1** (use online entry www.lonokecountyfair.com).
- E. Brucellosis suspects will not be admitted (see health regulations).
- F. Animals must be registered in exhibitor's name 30 days prior to show.
- G. Registered and non-registered: Non-registered can show but will show against registered cattle.
- H. Any dispute on age of non-registered cattle will be settled by superintendent.
- I. Must have health papers and descriptions.
- J. An exhibitor can only show 2 animals in one class, except where noted in a special group class.
- K. All cattle housed on fairgrounds must be entered in show.
- L. No premium money will be paid until stalls are cleaned and checked by superintendent.

ALL GENERAL & JUNIOR SHOW RULES APPLY

- a) Heifers in this Division will be judged as replacement dairy heifers. A heifer that has calved is ineligible to show.
- b) This competition is open to any heifer that is crossbred or purebred grade that is ineligible for registration and exhibit dairy characteristics.
- c) Heifers must be dehorned
- d) Commercial Dairy Heifers will show at the conclusion of purebred dairy show.
- e) Heifers of questionable age will be placed in appropriate classes at the discretion of the show superintendent and their decision is final.

- B. Bulls from 2 days to 6 months and have health papers.
- C. **Pre-registration of entries by Sept. 1** (use online entry www.lonokeycountyfair.com).
- D. All animals must be halter-broken and led by exhibitor.
- E. Ribbons and awards for all Pee Wee participants.
- F. Exhibitors can only show 1 animal in each division. This animal cannot be shown in any other division. If the exhibitor has other animals they may pay a \$5 entry fee and show in the Open division.
