It is required that all Horse Show contestants/exhibitors stall horses, until ALL stalls are full. If you stall a horse it MUST be shown in the horse show.

- A. Must pre-register Horses, Mules, and Donkeys by Sept. 1. Forms must be fully completed with name and phone number in case of emergencies (use online entry www.lonokecountyfair.com).
- B. Before unloading, Coggins must be checked by Superintendent IMMEDIATELY upon entry onto the fairgrounds. Negative Coggins required.
- C. No hay, feed or cleaning equipment to be stored in the horse barn entry or hallway.
- D. All equine stalled must remain on Exhibit until 11:00 pm on Saturday, or forfeit any prize money.
- E. Juniors are eligible to compete for herdsman, more information can be found under the "Junior Herdsman" portion of the catalogue.
- F. Juniors may compete in "showmanship". This must be marked on the pre-entry forms.
- G. No premium money will be issued until stalls are cleaned and checked by superintendent.

IMPORTANT: All horses and horse trailers must be unloaded and must remain on the west side of the horse barn at all times.

Horse and Pony Show

Special Rules:

- a. Open class contestants are required to pay \$5 per head.
- b. ABSOLUTELY NO STALLIONS ALLOWED. No stallions to be on the fairground property or in the parade.
- c. Exhibitor can show 1 horse in 1 class
- d. If there are not five horses in a class, classes will be combined accordingly. Also, all breeds will be combined according to classes.
- e. Horses and ponies will be judged on characteristics for its breed to include but not limited to coat, color, weight, cleanliness, confirmation, and overall conditions of your horse. The judge's decision is final.
- f. Exhibitors in all age division requirements are, as of Sept. 1. (Junior division ages 9-19), Open, PeeWee)
