GUIDELINES FOR ALL TEAM MEMBERS, STUDENTS AND STAFF:

To limit the possible spread of any virus, we encourage you and your family to remember the following recommendations taking the necessary precautions and following the latest CDC (Centers for Disease Control) recommendations:

- Anyone exhibiting symptoms of a cold or acute viral infection should not attend I AM A GENTLEMAN, INC. (IAAG) gatherings and activities at the church. These symptoms include fever, cough, sneezing, runny nose, diarrhea or feeling tired.
- Only IAAG Team Members, Students and Parents who have previously signed up to volunteer will be allowed in the IAAG gathering areas and outside of the IAAG gathering areas. Parents who frequent IAAG on a weekly basis and are not assigned to volunteer will be asked to remain sit in the public waiting area. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Anyone who has had pneumonia or other respiratory illness such as asthma or bronchitis should not travel or attend IAAG gatherings and activities.

- Anyone who has had compromise of their immune system or treatments such as chemotherapy should not travel or attend IAAG gatherings and activities.
- Precautions such as frequent hand washing, coughing into a barrier such as
 disposable tissues or such that can be safely discarded, and avoiding touching your
 face should be practiced for those attending IAAG gatherings and activities. We urge
 you to follow the directions of our team members and personnel who will direct you
 to wash your hands before you enter IAAG gathering spaces and to repeat the same
 when you leave.
- Hand sanitizers will be located at IAAG gathering facilities to allow you to utilize them
 if needed at any time.
- We urge all to practice acceptable social distancing practices by refraining from handshakes as a greeting, and instead a friendly nod, elbow bump, or the like.
