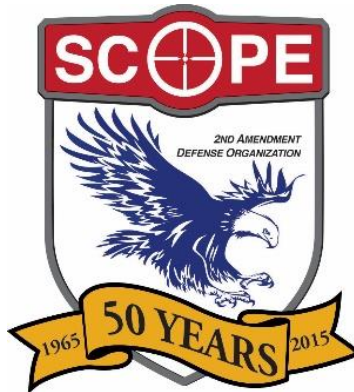


Wyoming County Minutes



Meeting Minutes –December 8, 2016

Call to Order 7 pm

- I. Pledge to flag by Veteran Mark Yount
- II. Winston Platt to lead us in prayer
- III. The Second Amendment to the Constitution was reviewed by Chairman.
- IV. Minutes- Gary Olcott presented the earlier emailed minutes on screen from the November meeting. On Motion, the minutes were approved as read.
- V. Secretary Report- Gary reviewed correspondence from Susan Marissa that Wyoming County Scope member Kathie Ricketson has been selected the State Scope Secretary. Congratulations.
- VI. Treasurer Report- Bill reviewed the financial details of income and expenses since last meeting on the screen for all to see. On Motion the report was approved as presented.
- VII. Chairman Report- Mark reported that Cattaraugus County Scope will not be accepting the money we allocated to them to help share in the election advertising expenses last month. The State Scope will be covering the cost with them.
- VIII. Wildlife Federation Report – Brian Krawczyk reported our own Scope treasurer Bill Popielinski has agreed to be co chairman for the federation.
- IX. Old Business –
 - a. Bill reported that 798 tickets of 1000 were sold. The drawing will be tonight at the end of the meeting. The estimated profit from the gun raffle is expected to be \$4,521 after printing of tickets and gun prices are deducted.
- X. New Business
 - a. The executive board and some members selected by the chairman will meet before next month's meeting to set some goals for our 2017 calendar year. Those goals will be discussed at the January

meeting with the whole membership. Mark opened the floor for ideas to be considered. The following ideas were encouraged to be included:

- i. Signs printed up for sale/distribution regarding upcoming governor election importance.
- ii. Having a second annual "200 Yard Shoot". Possibly a "100 Yard" and/or "50 Yard" shoot to encourage more youth and elderly participation.
- iii. Incorporating this coming year a Trap Shoot as was mentioned as a good idea this past year but not implemented.
- iv. Holding 2 or more "1 day" youth firearms introduction type class to church youth groups or other organizations with teens.
- v. Making a concerted effort to get the Wyoming County Board of Supervisors to rescind the ordinance that authorized concealed carry permit holders cannot carry firearms on county property. This topic was discussed at length as an important second amendment right. The following agreed to talk to their Town Supervisor before the next meeting to get a feel for the possibility of this effort being attained with the Board of Supervisors.
