



# **LONG PATH ALE**

**Style: German Altbier – Similar to Long Trail Ale**

Rich gold color with stark white head. Clean malty aroma with faint hint of hops. Finishes slightly dry with a mild hop aftertaste

Batch Size: 5 Gal  
OG: 1.047-1.048  
FG: 1.011-1.012  
IBU: 30  
SRM: 11-12  
ABV: 4.6%

## **GRAINS**

10 oz. Caramel 60L malt  
1/2 oz. Chocolate malt  
6 oz. White Wheat malt

## **EXTRACTS/ADJUNCTS**

6.5 lb. Light LME  
  
1 Whirlfloc Tablet (15 min.)

## **HOPS/SPICES**

2/3 oz. Northern Brewer (60 min.)  
  
1/3 oz. Willamette (15 min.)  
1/3 oz. Mt. Hood (15 min.)  
  
1/3 oz. Willamette (2 min.)  
1/3 oz. Cascade (2 min.)

**YEAST: 1<sup>st</sup> choice** – WLP036 Dusseldorf Alt Yeast

**2<sup>nd</sup> choice** – Fermentis S-04

## **Brewing Instructions**

1. Steep grains for 30 minutes @ 155 degrees.
2. Discard grain bag and bring kettle to a boil.
3. Add extracts stirring constantly until dissolved.
4. Lower heat and add first addition hops. 60 minute boil begins now. At this point you must not leave the kettle unattended – if a boil over begins, turn down the heat.
5. Raise heat to create a rolling boil.
6. Continue to add remaining ingredients as necessary. (note. times are based on remaining boil duration – example: (30 mins.) means add the ingredient when 30 minutes remain on the timer)
7. When boil is complete, turn off heat.
8. Cool the wort (unfermented beer) to 75 degrees.
9. Transfer to fermenter.
10. Aerate thoroughly, and then pitch the yeast.
