Saturday night we boarded the Celebration Belle in Moline, IL for a 3 hour dinner cruise that featured a spectacular view and music to entertain us.

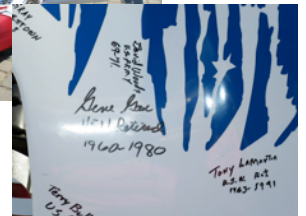

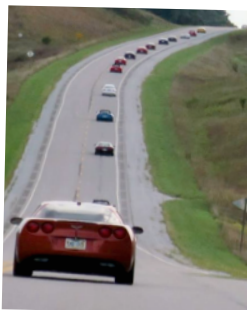




Elkhorn, Iowa & the Danish Windmill Tour

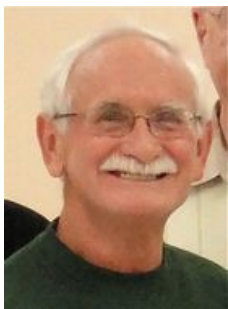
Supporting the Youth

GOVERNOR'S REPORT

Winter is coming on quickly and it's time to start thinking about putting the Corvettes away for the season. It sure did go quickly!! Our last events for the West Region will take place this month with the Drag events in Kearney, the Car

Show at Huber and the Sponsorship Rallye. As always, we look forward to seeing many of you at these events.

I will be voting for National and Regional Officers this month as well as the By-Law Changes and the 2016 convention bid from CCC. The ballot is on the membership database for all governors to cast their votes. The changes to the Competition Rulebook will take place at the November Governors' Meeting in St. Louis. We will also vote on the 2015 budget for NCCC at that meeting.

Here are the highlights of the rulebook changes. It will be a 2yr rulebook for 2015 - 2016. There will be a consolidation of safety information in a section in chapter 1. Applicable clarifications from 2013 and 2014 will be applied. Various grammatical changes have been made to align the rulebook with the use of the competition database. Sanctioned events will be allowed on convention weekends in the case of shortened conventions, i.e. when convention starts Tuesday or later,

the preceding weekend would be available; if the convention ends Thursday or earlier, the following weekend would be available. Flyer requirements will be changed to allow for written directions without a map and to include insurance coverage information. Competitors will be allowed to ride with novices and vice versa. Allow 12 year olds to ride as passengers at low speed events with appropriate approval and waivers. In group 3, rack and pinion steering will be allowed. Propose to allow updating and backdating of wheels in group 1 and 1S. Allow aftermarket items in Group 1 and 1S such as cool air intake, aftermarket shift kits, and cross over pipes. Class F and Class G will be combined as F/G for all groups. Class J and Class K will be combined as J/K for all groups. The C6 Z06 Carbon edition and the C6 Z06 with Z07 equipment will be moved from Class N to Class M. This is a summary of the rule changes. Dale and the RCD's have discussed these changes with competitors at convention and at other events around the country. He feels that this is a good move for NCCC. Dale will have a redline version of the complete rulebook to the webmaster on Monday. Dale pledged that there will be no changes to the rulebook at the November meeting. What you see is what you can take back to your clubs. A redline version of the proposed rulebook will be posted on the website for review.

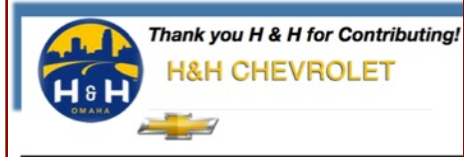
