

WINTER GUARD - JAMES THOMAS





Above: "The sabres from Designs by King are top of the line quality in the color guard world. These sabres will allow us to compete with the finest color guards from across the world when we attend the Winter Guard International World Championships in April of 2026. Furthermore, they will allow us to compete on a state and regional level throughout the season. The Winter Guard at Southlake Carroll is known as one of the top groups in not only the State of Texas, but also on a national level. We are a 3 time World Championships Finalist and have won numerous regional and state titles."

This is a 55 x 80 custom floor tarp to assist the nationally ranked winter guard program in their competitive endeavors.

"The winter guard programs have a history of success on a local and national scale. We have won numerous local competitions as well as the North Texas Color Guard Association Championships. The North Texas Color Guard Association is one of the largest winter guard associations in the country with over 400 active school units competing.

On a national scale, our Varsity winter guard has won several Winter Guard International Regional Championships as well as finishing in the top 15 on three separate occasions at the Winter Guard International World Championships. The WGI World Championships are held annually in Dayton, Ohio and attracts over 450 winter guards from around the world. We attend the world championships every other year.

We are one of the most successful color / winter guards in not only the North Texas area, but in the state of Texas. And it is with help of organizations like the PTO, we have the opportunity to achieve and compete at high levels. Having the opportunity to teach our students teamwork, leadership, confidence, commitment, etc is an absolute value to their experience in Southlake and beyond." - James Thomas
